**for a piano player**

Play **70 different** tones and/or noises during **one minute**.

Play **only** sequences of tones/noises.

Do not play chords, clusters, any kind of tone-aggregations or glissandos.

**Do not repeat** any tone/noise.

Noises should be produced **only** by using the instrument.

**Avoid** using any other instrument and/or your voice.

Play **at least 30** tones/noises using the body of the instrument and the strings in the piano.

**63 tones/noises** should be performed in a quiet manner (not too quiet). **7 tones/noises** should be performed loudly or very loudly. Distribute these 7 tones/noises during the whole minute. Do not play 2 loud tones/noises in sequence.

The last tone/noise should be performed exactly at the 59<sup>th</sup> second of the one minute duration.
