A further parallel between Riadis and Moussorgsky is the unfinished state of his major works (not songs), often a profusion of sketches. Musicologists should work many years for a critical ed. of the composer's complete MSS, which other experts might use as the basis for subsequent performing editions. Such a task remains one of the " desiderata " of Gr. musicology. The effort will not be easy. For nearly every composition (many songs included) Riadis's perfectionism, disguising a psychological instability, has left several versions, often substantially differing and defying chronological classification : with rare exceptions MSS are undated. Still worse, they are often hastily written with very light pencil, which makes photocopying problematic, and full of illegible corrections and erasures. In chamber music it is sometimes very difficult to establish the unity of a score and in songs or pf works we are offered a choice of several titles or versions of a title. They exist even corrections, by the composer, of songs already published, which makes the forthcoming ed. of 16 songs by F. Anoyanakis a major " tour de force ".

This is the first attempt by a musicologist (Mrs Elisa Riadi having attempted to compile a provisional, yet helpful, catalogue of the MSS and published works) to compile a list of the main titles, omitting juvenilia, material for the moment at least undefinable, titles only mentioned by various authors (i.e. the mysterious " Japanese Screens ") and confining mostly to the main MSS of the composer.

Works are in MS form, unless otherwise stated. The composer almost never suggests the kind of voice he wanted for a song. In unpublished song-collections the order of songs remains in many cases a matter of conjecture. We keep French titles where used by the composer.

-This will be very useful for small medical libraries. A subtlety of note, (I guess for) adhesives must be used, unlike bookbinding or tape which gives short time protection against water damage while dry, but adhesive strength will be lost as soon as it gets wet, so it is "irreversible," and the more moisture there is the more damage there will be, just as one like plastic materials are quickdry, resealable, etc., but are much more difficult to remove if they are stuck on. I would suggest that the adhesive be used in a thin film, and that the adhesive be applied to the back of the paper, not the front, so that the paper can be easily removed if it gets wet. This is the best way to do it, but I have not tried it.

This is a good book for anyone who wants to learn how to bind books, and it is also a good reference for anyone who wants to learn how to repair old books.
