PROGRAM NOTES

Two happy events marked the year 2008. The first was the successful treatment of a serious illness in the composer's family. The second was the graduation of the composer from Aristotle's University Dept of Musical Studies, where he studied composition with composer/professor Christos Samaras. This composition was done as part of the Thesis required before graduation.

The composer strongly believes that music is there to express feelings and emotions. In this work therefore, he tried to express in musical terms the emotional state prevailing during the four basic periods of the illness: (a) the despair felt after the discovery of the illness, (b) the serenity which followed after a (seemingly) successful treatment, (c) the worry of not knowing when the illness will strike again, and finally, (d) the hope that the illness is definitely over and everything will be all right from now on. The work therefore is divided in four distinctive parts, though closely connected to each other.

In this respect this music is of a "programmatic" nature. But isn't it so with most of the various kinds of music?
